4 with a victory. In order for any of those
5 scenarios to take place, certain athletes
6 needed to step up and help out the team.
7 Our top 3 ran outstanding races, with Nick
8 Paneto running virtually alone and dropping
9 an impressive 16:32. Stephen Perrillo
10 managed to hold off the competition and
11 finish in 2nd. Andrew Johnson was really
12 close to coming in 3rd but had two strong
13 Mount Academy runners just 4 seconds
14 ahead of him. He will become stronger than
15 them over the next 2-3 weeks. With
16 Hackman still being out of commission, we
17 needed someone to step up. Freshman Greg
18 Hannibal answered that call, breaking up
19 the Mount Academy pack. With both Perez
20 and Albanese not far behind, we ended up
21 with a narrow victory of 27-28. With #3
22 ranked Cornwall going undefeated, that
23 puts us in a respectable 2nd place in
24 Division III, considering we just defeated the
25 defending Class C State Champs and Class B
State ranked #5 team... it's not too shabby.
Looking at the results and comparing them
to a couple weeks ago, it's pretty impressive
to see how much some have improved. Let's
keep the momentum going into Brown, and
then Counties.
